ILOs survey context

- Update ILOs roughly every five years
- Survey Construction
 - Integrated inputs from campus community (Fall 2019 Flexday activity, the campuswide follow up survey, input on the objectives for the Strategic Plan, and ILOs from the National Association of Colleges and Employers*)
- Survey asks about 8 ILOs (5 current and 3 new)

Data Collection

- Survey opened from April 17th to May 1st 2020 (2 weeks)
- Survey sent via email to all Chabot staff and faculty
 - Reminder email sent; deadline extended
 - Survey announced and link shared at academic senate, classified senate, presidents council
 - Academic Senate President Miguel Colon asked senators to share in division meetings and encourage participation
- Total respondents: 68
