Summary: Can we increase completions?

- Completions overall went up substantially
 What are we doing to sustain this?
- Completions in 3 years: not much increase
 - Most students take longer than 3 years to complete their educational goal
 - Full-time students more likely to complete
- → What are we doing to increase this?
 Which student groups do we focus on?

AB 705 requires: completion within 1 year of Transfer-level English and Math

- Asked to place most transfer-seeking students in transfer English or transfer Math
 - Unless they are "highly unlikely" to succeed in the transfer level course.
 - **Statewide:** More succeed if started in transfer level
 - **Chabot:** Don't know if our students will succeed
- How many do complete within one year?
- What helps more complete these courses?

What Helps: More full-time (Laser) students More Laser FT College students
